4th of July Impaired Driving Enforcement Campaign

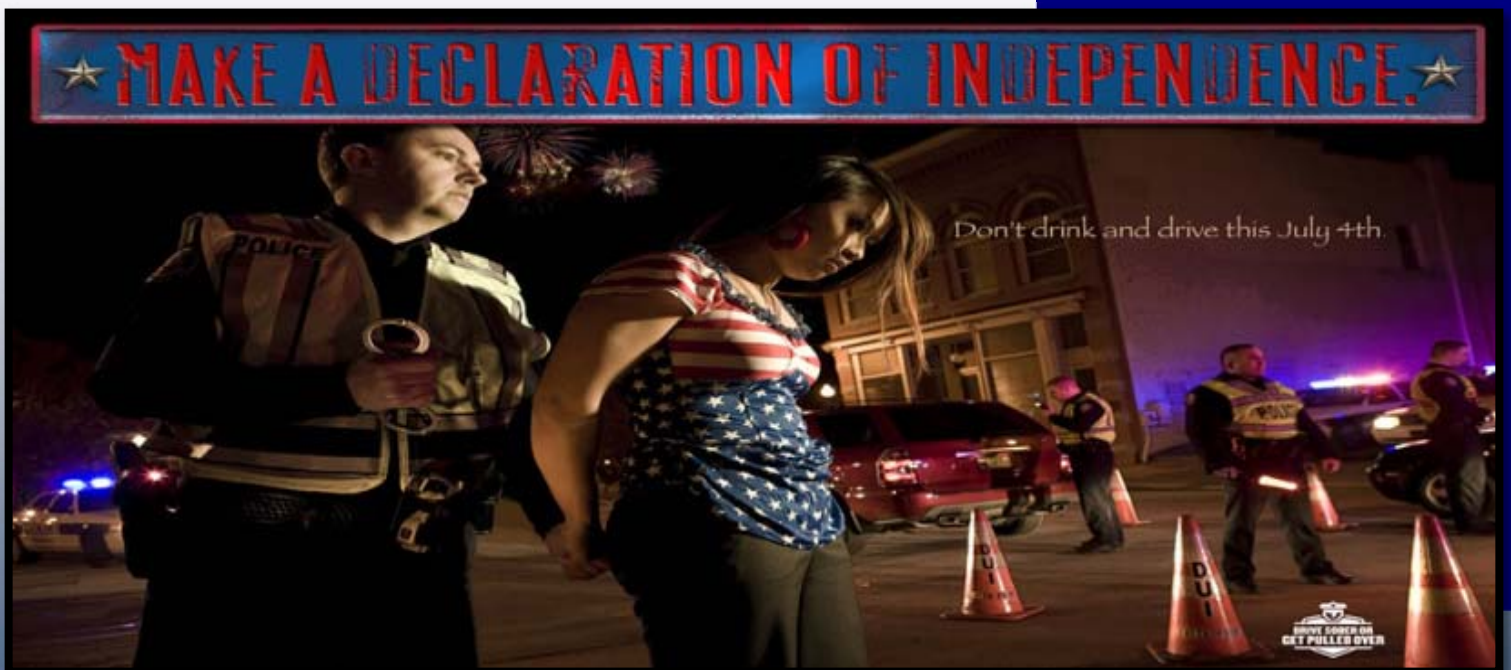

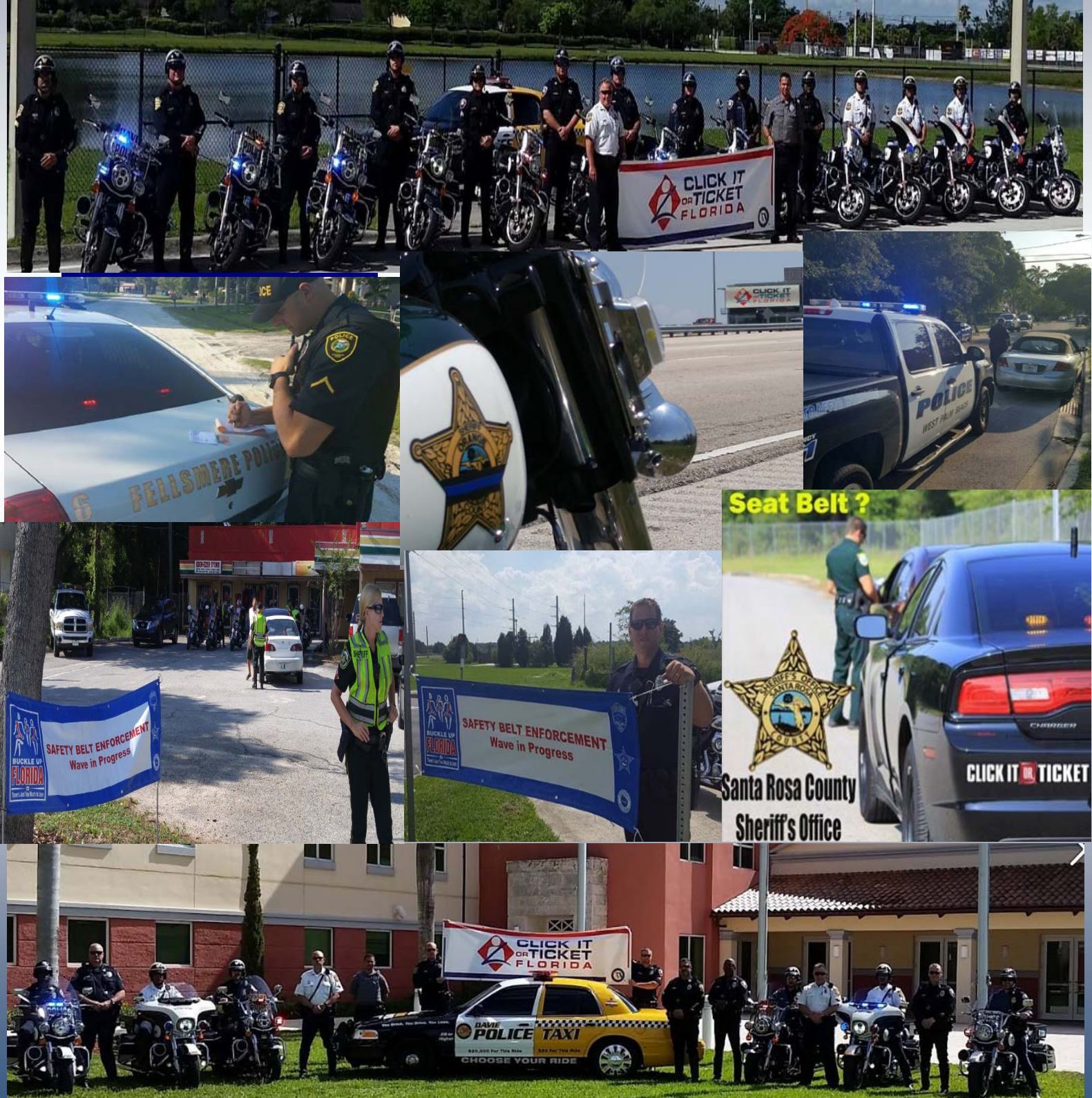
The Florida CIOT Challenge recognizes the best overall traffic safety initiatives promoting safer driving in the agency's community.

Buckle Up! Your Family Is Waiting For You –

A high school student in Washington found that 10 percent of the students driving to school were not wearing a seat belt. She decided to tackle this issue through the development of a year-long safe driving campaign. One project was a three-week-long seat belt campaign called, “Buckle Up: Your Family is Waiting for You!” The campaign resulted in increased seat belt use among fellow-students and, by the end, 96 percent were arriving to school protected by seat belts.

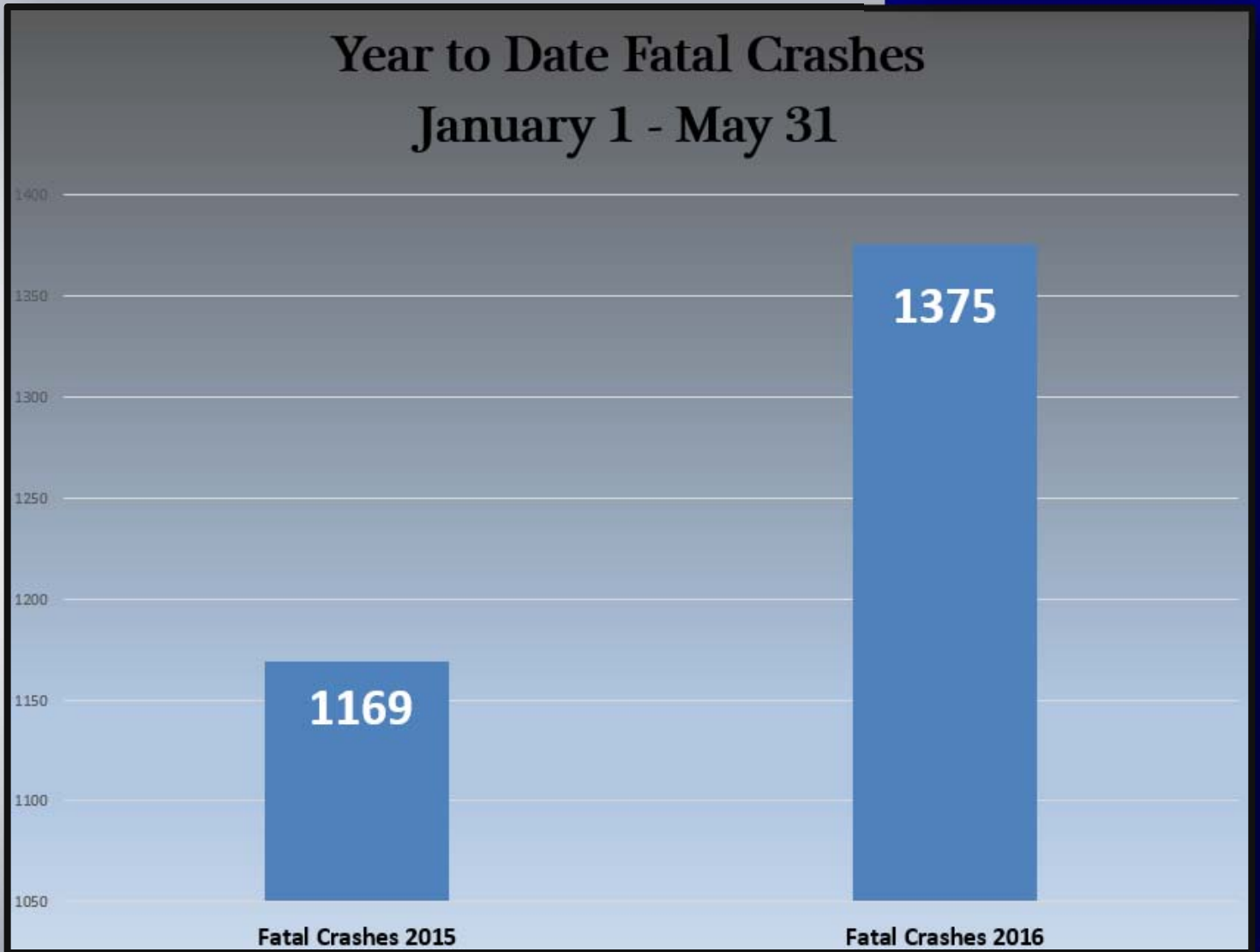
